(General Information)

Why become ENplus® certified?

ENplus® certification scheme for wood pellet quality is an international system for quality assurance of production and logistics of wood pellets. The aim is to guarantee a smooth operation with ENplus® certified pellets for small scale heating appliances through strict requirements concerning pellet quality as well as a control of the entire supply chain from production through distribution to end-user. The continuous conformity to the requirements is guaranteed by external inspections and testing as well as regular internal monitoring of the quality and the implementation of a comprehensive quality assurance system.

How to get an ENplus® license?

The assignment of the ENplus® license is done by the responsible ENplus® scheme management. The ENplus® National Licensor in charge for all involved countries are listed on www.enplus-pellets.eu. For countries without a national scheme management, EPC (European Pellet Council)/Bioenergy Europe acts as international ENplus® scheme management.

Certification with HolzforSchung Austria

Depending on the business activities, on-site audits, remote audits, sampling and testing need to be conducted in accordance with requirements of the ENplus® certification scheme. The regular surveillance of producers, traders and service providers through trained and experienced auditors ensures that only certified pellets are sold as such. HolzforSchung Austria is listed by the EPC as a certification and testing body for the ENplus® certification scheme. For detailed information please see www.holzforSchung.at.
