

Certification of Chain of Custody

General Information

Wood based products pass through several stations of ownership between the forest and the consumer. This chain, the Chain of Custody (CoC), may have different steps and length. It is crucial is that all owners within this chain (traders as well as manufacturers) hold a certificate. The verification of trader, producers and processors by a notified body such as Holzforschung Austria (www.holzforschung.at) guaranteed that only certified products can be sold as such. Important elements of the assessments are the verification of the origin of the timber, the plausibility of the quantity and the long-term management of the prevention of the incorrect mixture of certified and non-certified timber. Consequently FSC-certified timber remains at all times and clearly identifiable through the whole sequence of processing and trade. Overview of the certification procedures

Inquiry to the Certification Body



 $\operatorname{\mathsf{Bid}}$ proposal management based on the information given by the inquiring company



Application for certification by the company using the application form



Preliminary talk for the preparation of the certification audit



Evaluation of submitted documents



First on-site inspection



If necessary, subsequent submitting of additional documents by the company or additional inspection



After a positive outcome oft he first inspection issuing of a first inspecion and certification report as well as a certificate



Yearly on-site inspection of the compliance of the requirements



Recertification inspection after five years and issuing of a new certificate
